El Mundo Zurdo 9: Selected Academic and Creative Works from the 2022 Meeting of the Society for the Study of Gloria Anzaldúa

The editors of the selected conference proceedings, *El Mundo Zurdo 9*, invite you to submit your revised paper or your creative work for consideration by **May 20th**, **2023**.

When preparing your submission, please follow these guidelines:

- 1. Use Times New Roman, size 12 font.
- 2. Double space the entire paper including endnotes and Works Cited.
- 3. Use endnotes instead of footnotes.
- 4. Page limit is 20 pages not including references. Short papers presented at the conference will also be considered.
- 5. Insert appropriate accent marks for Spanish text, especially all Spanish names.
- 6. Use MLA (Modern Languages Association) style (8th edition) for Works Cited and endnotes. *Papers submitted in formats other than MLA will not be reviewed.*
- 7. Write: "SSGA El Mundo Zurdo 8 submission" on the Subject line of your email.
- 8. Include a brief (50-75 word) author bio.
- 9. For poetry submissions, no more than 3 poems and no more than 5 pages can be submitted.
- 10. Papers can be submitted in Spanish if they were presented at the conference in Spanish.
- 11. On the first page of your manuscript, center your title at the top of the page, followed by your name and affiliation underneath it.
- 12. Left justify the entire paper including subheadings in this fashion:

Subheading Level 2 Subheading Level 3

- 13. Save your essay/poetry/creative writing as a Microsoft Word file. Use the following convention to name your file: "yourfirstinitiallastnameSSGA.doc" for example: ncantuSSGA.doc. Do not include accent marks in the file name.
- 14. If your submission includes images or documents, they will require appropriate permissions and must use accurate citations for these sources before final publication.

Submit your paper to <u>elmundozurdosubmissions@gmail.com</u> by <u>midnight (CST)</u>, <u>May 20, 2023</u>. Editors will notify you of the status of your submission (accept, accept with revision, reject, etc.,) by Sep 1, 2023. Final drafts will be due by Oct 15, 2023.
